The Hiroshima Animation Season (HAS) is a film festival that brings together filmmakers from all over the world, as well as related parties and core fans who love and support the creativity of filmmakers. We will introduce creators who have personally uncovered the potential and future of animation, transcending the boundaries of old and new, commercial and non-commercial.
